Introduction

At Sapno Ke Pankh, our mission is deeply rooted in love, care, and the unwavering belief that every child—regardless of their background—deserves the opportunity to dream, learn, and thrive. This year at Nanhe Kadam Pathshala, we took bold strides to transform lives, not just through academics, but by nurturing the heart and soul of every student who walks through our gates.

This report is not just a summary of milestones—it is a heartfelt narrative of our collective hope, resilience, and progress. In AY 2024-25, we evolved into more than a school. We became a vibrant community of learners, dreamers, and changemakers.

With initiatives like value education, daily meditation, Fun Saturdays, monthly “Attendance Ace” awards, and birthday celebrations, we created a nurturing space that uplifts not only minds but also spirits.

Student Growth

Our student strength surged from 123 to 181, a powerful reminder that our dream is resonating—and growing. The rise in enrollment to 181 students is not just a number—it is 58 more children who now have a safe space to learn, dream, and flourish.

Infrastructure Upgrade

During the last year, we transformed our modest space to improve our infrastructure, providing better facilities and a conducive learning environment by:

- Adding 4 new classrooms to support over 200 students
- Equipping every room with air coolers and power backup
- Providing each child with a folding study table
- Ensuring clean water through RO filtration and water cooler
- Installing CCTV and a public address system for improved safety and communication
- Enhancing administrative support with a new laser printer

These improvements were made possible through the kindness of our donors and well-wishers, who believed in the potential of our children.

Academics

- **Exams:** 1st Term Exams 18th – 23rd Sep | 2nd Term Exams 16th – 21st Dec | Final Exams 19th – 25th Mar
- **Parent Teacher Meetings (PTM)**
 - 1st Quarterly PTM (30th Sep & 1st Oct) - Teachers shared academic progress and exam results with parents.
 - 2nd Quarterly PTM (23rd - 24th Jan): Focus on academic progress and counseling parents to monitor and minimize cellphone usage and screen time for children at home.
- **Class Progression:** Based on performance in 1st term exams, some students were promoted to higher, age-appropriate classes.
- **Graduation and Award Ceremony** on 2nd April was a celebration of effort, perseverance, and progress. We were deeply honored to have Mr. Ashish from Ernst & Young, Mr. Lalit from Chance Foundation, and Ms. Sheela from Child Survival India as our chief guests. Their presence and encouragement meant the world to our students and team.

Extra-Curricular Activities

- Students eagerly look forward to fun Saturdays for various exciting activities, these include
 - Extra-curricular activities like drawing, art & craft, music. These sessions are conducted by our teacher and multiple volunteers (students and young adults).
 - Visits from families to celebrate their special occasions, specially birthdays. All students look forward to the cake and treats!
 - Visits from generous well-wishers to distribute goodies to our students.
- Yoga sessions and daily meditation are an integral part of our school curriculum.

Value Education

In partnership with MaitriBodh Parivaar, we introduced a transformative Value Education Curriculum. A teacher training program was conducted on 19th November and curriculum books were distributed to the students. With trained teachers and specially designed books, our children are learning empathy, responsibility, and inner peace—traits that shape strong, kind, and resilient individuals.

Workshops & Awareness

- **Women Safety Workshop** by Haryana Police created awareness on how to report any incident to the police and seek help.
- **Mental Health Awareness Workshop** by Heart2Heart Foundation helped our teachers in identifying students who need extra care and help.
- **Career Guidance and Mentoring session by ICFAI Business School** for Grade 4 and 5 students.
- **Save the Environment workshop** by a passionate young IT professional raised awareness about the importance of being environmentally conscious and caring for planet earth.

These workshops have helped our students with essential life skills and grow stronger.

Celebrations

- **Independence Day** on 14th August. In addition to flag hoisting, school students organized a cultural program consisting of scintillating dance performances, poem recital and singing.
- **Teachers Day** on 5th September
- **Ganesh Chaturthi** on 7th September
- **School's 5th Anniversary** on 7th October
- Painting activity on 10th October to celebrate **Navaratri & Dussehra**
- **Christmas** was celebrated on 24th December. Children had a great time singing Christmas carols, enjoying cake in red Santa caps!
- **Welcomed Year 2025** with Havan on 3rd January
- **Republic Day** on 25th January. Flag unfurling was followed by a cultural program by students.
- **Basant Panchami** on 4th February. Pooja was performed to seek blessings from Goddess Saraswati.

These celebrations have brought joy and excitement to our students, creating memorable experiences and fostering a sense of belonging.

Fundraising & Community Participation

This year marked our first-ever active fundraising participation in Diwali carnivals across Gurgaon. The experience was enriching and empowering, opening new doors to sustain our school's growth.

Continued support from all our patrons has encouraged us to dream bigger and bolder. We are excited about our plan to undertake the following expansion initiatives:

1. On 1st May we are moving to a bigger school building with 18 spacious classrooms, a large multi-purpose hall for extracurricular activities, a computer lab etc. to accommodate ~300 students.
2. Introduce Grade 7, 8, 9 and 10.
3. Implement smart classrooms with AV and internet support.
4. Start computer literacy classes for Grade 6-10.
5. Launch regular self-defense, martial arts, dance and music coaching sessions.
6. Acquire equipment for hosting large-scale school events and activities.
7. Upgrade existing infrastructure for a better learning experience.
